## YOUTH CITY HANDICAP TOURNAMENT RULES

**1. Eligibility:** The tournament is open to all current PPUSBC members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of August 1, 2024, and have maintained compliance with USBC Youth Rule 400. Participants may be required to show a current USBC membership card at check-in. Non-USBC and/or non-PPUSBC bowlers will be required to pay the required membership fees prior to bowling.

**2. Participation:** This tournament includes 3 separate events; Team, Doubles and Singles. Bowlers may bowl as many of the events as they would like. Bowlers may enter multiple team events. No more than two bowlers may participate together on multiple teams. Multiple entries are allowed in doubles with a different partner. Individual bowlers may place only once in the top 10 for the singles event.

**3. Entry Fees:** Entry fees per bowler, per event, is \$25.00 broken down as follows: prize fund paid in the form of scholarships, \$10.00 and \$15.00 for tournament expenses. PRIZE FUND WILL BE RETURNED 100% in the form of awards and scholarships.

**4. No Refunds:** No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund once the tournament begins. Prior to the start of the tournament, a refund may be given if the team or individual notifies the tournament manager or tournament director that they will be unable to bowl.

**5. Prize Ratio:** 1 in 5 entries per division. Each youth winner will receive an award. In the event of a tie, duplicate awards will be given. Results will be posted to our website: [www.pikespeakusbc.com](http://www.pikespeakusbc.com) and on Facebook. Scholarship amounts will be determined by the number of entries in each division. Scholarships will be managed by SMART through USBC. Bowlers will have EIGHT years from high school graduation to use the scholarships. Expired funds will revert to the PPUSBC Youth Scholarship Fund.

**6. Averages:** The highest 2023-2024 book average of 12 games or more will be used. If the bowler does not have a 2023-2024 book average, a current league average of 12 games or more as of December 28, 2024, can be used. Youth without either of these averages will be assigned an average based on his or her division. Age Division are as follows: Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 15 and Under 18.

Age as of August 1, 2024, determines the division (assigned average in parenthesis):

BANTAMS - U8	PREPS - U10	JUNIORS - U12	SENIORS - U15	MAJORS - U18

All Team divisions will have (4) four-member teams. Boys and girls will compete against each other. Doubles will be any combination of entrants. The oldest bowler will determine the division of the event.

**7. Handicap:** Handicap will be 90% of 220.

**8. Dress Code:** No hats, cutoffs, tank tops, muscle shirts, clothing with offensive language and/or pictures, or bare midriffs will be allowed.

Shorts/skorts/skirts may be worn only if the said apparel is no shorter than the fingertips of the bowler, when their arms are extended straight down at their sides. No headphones or earbuds are allowed. No electronic devices will be allowed in the settee area. The tournament director shall have final say in compliance with the dress code. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prizes.

**9. Check-In Times:** Check in will begin one hour prior to the squad time.

**10. Lane Assignments:** All lane assignments are to be made by the tournament director. If it becomes necessary to reschedule bowlers in any event, it will be done at the discretion of the tournament director. In case of machine failure and it becomes impossible to complete an event within the allotted time, the event will be rescheduled, and bowling will resume at the point where it was discontinued.

**11. Average Verification:** It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler or someone else. PPUSBC 10-pin rule is in effect which means if a bowler has a current average that is 10 or more pins higher than the entering average, they must notify a tournament official prior to the start of competition. Failure to use the proper average or make the correction, may disqualify the bowler and forfeit all entry fees.

**12. Tardy Bowlers:** Tardy bowlers will start in the frame being bowled when they are ready for tournament play. They will receive a score of zero for any frames missed. Bowlers refusing to start at the scheduled time shall forfeit their entry fee and will not be allowed to compete.

**13. Time Limit:** A time-limit will be imposed for all events of this tournament, not to exceed three hours for the team and three hours for combined doubles and singles. Any pairs falling behind will be provided warnings by tournament officials. If an event cannot be completed within the allotted time-frame (excluding lane breakdowns, scoring problems, etc.), any frames left to bowl may be marked as a zero.

**14. Lane Breakdown:** In the event of a lane breakdown, play will proceed as follows: \*\*During competition, if bowlers sit for more than 10 minutes or are required to move pairs, each bowler will be allowed one ball per lane to warm up. \*\*If the breakdown occurs during practice, the remaining practice time will be allowed to be completed following the repair.

**15. Substitutes:** All substitutions must be made through the tournament office.

**16. Bowling Balls:** Once practice is over and competition begins, surface alteration will not be allowed. During competition, a bowler may clean their ball using a **shammy or dry towel only**.

**17. Score Sheets:** After a score sheet has been signed by a contestant or team captain, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign the score sheet only after ensuring its accuracy. Computer printouts from the participating center will be the official score sheet in all cases. These will be kept on file for 10 days.

**18. Protests:** Any protests pertaining to interpretation or application of tournament rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament director, with a copy to USBC and filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

**19. Additional Rules:**

A) All food and beverages must be kept out of the settee area.

B) Only bowlers, tournament officials, or center staff will be allowed in the settee area. **COACHES WITH RVP AND SAFESPORT WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE SETTEE AREA.**

**USBC rules and regulations will apply in all instances not specifically covered in the above rules as stated. The PPUSBC tournament director will make a ruling on all questions, disputes, and rules not covered by these tournament rules. No use of tobacco products or consumption of alcoholic beverages during the tournament.**
