COLORADO SPRINGS SENIOR MASTERS RULES

- 1. Eligibility: This scratch tournament is open to all USBC members aged 50 and over as of the day of the tournament. Entries are limited to 80 entrants.
- 2. Entry Fees: The entry fee is \$140 if paid by April 20, 2025, and \$150 after April 20, 2025, including walk-ins. Walk-ins will only be allowed if space is available.
- 3. No Refunds: No individual shall be entitled to a refund if a bowler does not bowl, is a no-show, or is unable to complete the qualifying rounds. Replacement bowlers will be taken from the standby list.
- 4. Prize Ratio: 1 in 3. Expenses will be \$64 and prize fund will be \$76 based on 40 entries.
- 5. Dress Code: Collared shirts or mock bowling shirts for all. Men must wear dress slacks. Ladies can wear skirts, skorts, or slacks. Skorts/skirts may be worn only if the said apparel is no shorter than the fingertips of the bowlers when their arms are extended straight down at their sides. No hats, no shorts, no tank tops, no jeans. No headphones or earbuds will be allowed. *Failure to adhere to this rule will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prizes.*
- 6. Check-In Times: Check-in will begin approximately one hour prior to the start of the tournament. *Match Play:* A 60-minute break may occur between the qualifying and match play rounds. Bowlers must be checked in no later than 15 minutes before their scheduled time to bowl. Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice prior to the first match of match play.
- 7. Lane Assignments: Lane assignments are assigned by the tournament director at check-in.
- 8. Tardy Bowlers: A tardy pre-paid bowler may be replaced by a walk-in bowler, or bowler from the stand-by list depending on the squad size. A tardy bowler may still compete, however all missed frames will be given a score of zero.
- **9.** Score Sheets: After a score sheet has been signed by a contestant, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign the score sheet only after ensuring its accuracy. Computer printouts from the participating center will be the official score sheet in all cases. These will be kept on file for ten days.
- **10.** Bowling Balls: Once practice is over and competition begins, surface alteration will not be allowed. Shammy or dry towel only. No further surface alterations allowed until completion of the tournament.
- **11. Tournament format:**
 - a. Qualifying round: There will be 6 games of qualifying. Lane movement will be determined by number of entries and number of lanes used. Total pins after 6 games qualifying will determine the top 8 bowlers that will advance to single elimination match play bracket. Upon completion of the qualifying round, if a tie exists for the final position needed to complete the match play field, one complete game will be bowled by all bowlers who are tied. If a tie still exists after said game, a ONE BALL ROLL-OFF will be bowled until the tie is broken. Said roll-off will be bowled on same lane each participant finished the additional roll-off game. The bowler on the odd lane will bowl first, but instead of completing the frame, they will alternate shots until the match is decided. Failure of any contestent to remain qualifying and a single of a tig will constitute a forfaiture.
 - decided. Failure of any contestant to remain available in case of a tie will constitute a forfeiture. **b.** Finals round: The top eight bowlers by pinfall will make the match play bracket, which consists of 2-game matches. Total pinfall for the 2 games determines the winner of the match, who will move on to the next round. Higher seed has a choice of starting lane. Two practice halls on each lane will be allowed for each round of match play after the
 - has a choice of starting lane. Two practice balls on each lane will be allowed for each round of match play after the first round. Any ball delivered on the wrong lane that results in a strike will be a "dead ball" and will be re-bowled on the correct lane. If it does not strike, said ball will be counted. This includes the first frame of the first game. See USBC Rule 9.
- **12. Protests:** Any protests pertaining to interpretation or application of tournament rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament director, with a copy to USBC and filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

USBC rules and regulations will apply in all instances not specifically covered in the above rules as stated. The PPUSBC tournament director will make rulings on all questions, disputes, and rules not covered by these tournament rules.
